Reedsburg Utility Announces Hydrant Flushing and Water Main Maintenance

(Reedsburg, WI) September 30, 2016 – Flushing water hydrants and having routine water main maintenance is an important procedure when it comes to a community's safety. It's necessary to flush water hydrants in order to test that there is adequate water flow and pressure. Flushing is also done to remove any sediment from the pipes in order to maintain water clarity and quality in the distribution pipes. Now, throughout the month of October you may see Water Utility personnel in various areas releasing water from hydrants Monday thru Friday 7am to 4pm, the expected completion date of the maintenance is October 31st.

Occasionally when water hydrants are flushed you may notice a discoloration in your tap water. If this happens, run the cold water tap for a few minutes until the water runs clear. If the water does not run clear the first time, wait a few minutes and run the water again, rest assured the water is safe to drink.
