## Up to \$2,000 towards the purchase of energy efficient equipment.

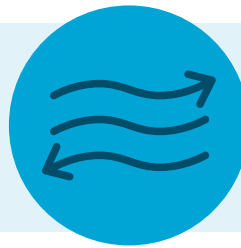
Qualifying small business customers are eligible for grants of up to \$2,000 which can be used to purchase new equipment or implement energy efficiency projects. All projects must qualify for Focus on Energy rebates to be eligible for a Reedsburg Utility Commission (RUC) grant. The project application deadline is September 30, 2021.

**To apply, go to our website and submit an application form with a quote of your project's total cost.**

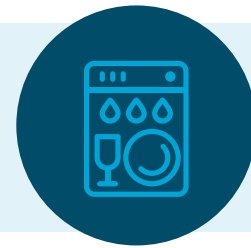
